

1. The Rockford City Council met in regulars session at City Hall on Tuesday June 13, 2017. Mayor Protem Marth called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Council Member Arndt, Marth, Smith, Stokes and with Johnson absent. Citizens present were Dennis Ginther, Sharon Hicok, Aaron Pearson with Rockford Lion Club, Andy Achenbach, Frank Kelly with Heartland Asphalt, Mark Kroemer with WWA, Del Duffield & Laurie Pederson with Twin Strike Emporium and Employee Randy Schweizer.

Motion Arndt, sec. Stokes to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to open Public Hearing at 7:31 p.m. for discussing Ordinance #247 to help City officials deal with the public health and safety problems created by the Infusion of large number of people into the City of Rockford when the Des Moines Register's Annual Great Bicycle Ride Across Iowa arrives on July 26, 2017 and Miscellaneous Permits for vendors. All ayes roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion Stokes, sec. Arndt to close hearing at 7:32 p.m.

3. Motion Smith, sec. Stokes to approve Resolution #2017-11 adopting Ordinance #247 regarding Ragbrai Vendor fees and that the statutory rule requiring said Ordinance Amendment to be considered and voted on for passage at two Council meetings prior to the meeting at which it is to be finally passed, be waived. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Motion carried.
4. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to approve consent agenda consisting of May 9th Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims and Expenses, Liquor License for Cenex Express, Steve's on Main, Rockford Fire Department, Sunday Liquor License for Twin Strike Emporium and Cigarette Permit for Cenex. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
5. Bid from Heartland Asphalt was opened by Mayor Protem Marth. Discussion was held.
6. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to approve Resolution #2017-12 Street Paving Project bid items #1 through #8 of Heartland Asphalt bid consisting of Main Ave from 2nd St N.W. to Main Street 1st Ave S.W. South End. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Motion carried.
7. Motion Smith, sec. Stokes to approve Resolution #2017-13, 28E Law Enforcement Agreement with the Floyd County Sheriff's Department. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Motion carried.
8. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to let out for bids of the Rockford Public Library roof and to be open on June 30th, 2017 for the July 10th 2017 meeting. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
9. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to approve the Rockford Lions Club permission to put Electronic sign on City property at City Hall or the Rockford Public Library. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
10. City is still working on updating the City Code Book.
11. Motion Smith, sec. Arndt to approve Auchesetter Floor Cleaning to wax City Hall floors on June 19th. All ayes. Motion carried.

12. Bid from Twin Strike Emporium and Steve's on Main were opened by Mayor Protem Marth for property of 122 W. Main Ave. Discussion was held.
13. Motion was made by Arndt with lack of a second to approve the bid from Twin Strike Emporium for \$250.00.
14. Motion Stoke's. Sec. Marth to reject all bids for the property of 122 W. Main Ave. at this time. Passed ayes: Marth, Smith, Stokes. naves: Arndt.
15. Johnson Addition was tabled until next meeting.
16. Public Works Director, Randy Schweizer reported on mowing, calls, spraying, and looking into nuisance ordinance.
