AUGUST 8, 2017

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at City Hall on Tuesday, August 8, 2017. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Council Members Smith, Stokes, Johnson, Arndt and Marth. Citizen's present were Dennis Ginther, Andy Achenbach, Myron Stadtlander, Tod Cleghorn, Stacie Stokes and Frank Kelly with Heartland Asphalt.


Motion Arndt, sec. Marth to approve the posted agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

2. Motion Smith, sec. Stokes to approve the consent agenda consisting of July 12th & 21st Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims and Expenses, Liquor License and Cigarette Permit for Yesway. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
3. Motion Arndt, sec. Smith to approve change order to Heartland Asphalt street project to include streets 7th St N.E. from 2nd Ave to Main St. and 6th St N.W. from 1st Ave to Main St and 2 patches on 4th St N.W. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
4. Motion Johnson, sec. Stokes to put out for bids the city's old cub cadet. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
5. Discussion was held on the Rockford Public Library roof construction being started the 2nd or 3rd week in September.
6. Wyatt Park Campground attendant and fees tabled until next meeting.
7. Motion Johnson, sec. Arndt to approve waiving the Community Center fee for Jim Fisher Cancer benefit. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
8. Motion Marth, sec. Johnson to approve Resolution #2017-15 Authorizing transfer of Emergency Funds in the amount of \$5,319.74 to the general account. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
9. Motion was made by Arndt, with lack of a second to approve the Johnson addition properties to be deeded over to the City of Rockford.
10. Discussion was held on asking Wayne Johnson on paying for each property for breach of contract with the Johnson addition with the decision being made at the September meeting on what option the council will do.

11. Mayor Johnson reported on talking with Floyd County Public Health about a property. He also talked about how well RAGBRAI went.
