

**ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING
& REGULAR MEETING**

MARCH 13, 2018

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at City Hall on Tuesday, March 13, 2018. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. Present were Council Members Paulus, Stokes, Johnson, Arndt and Marth. Citizens present were Dennis Ginther, Gayle Uker, and RRMR Summer Rec Committee members Rick Heit & Mike McGregor and Public Works Director Randy Schweizer.

Motion Marth, sec. Arndt to approve the posted agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
2. Motion Marth, sec. Johnson to open Budget Hearing at 7:31 P.M. for purposed 2018-2019 City Budget as published. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Mayor asked for any written or oral objections or comments: there being none, motion Marth, sec. Stokes to close Budget Hearing at 7:32 P.M.
3. Motion Johnson, sec. Marth to approve Resolution #2018-06 adopting the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2019. Passed with the following roll call vote: Arndt, Marth, Paulus, Stokes and Johnson.
4. Motion Johnson, sec. Paulus to approve the consent agenda consisting of February 13th, 2018 Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims and Expenses. All ayes. Motion carried.
5. Motion Johnson, sec. Marth to hire Calhoun and Burns for the Main Street bridge inspection. All ayes. Motion carried.
6. Snow Removal was tabled until next meeting.
7. Motion Marth, sec. Stokes to approve to purchase a 6 inch JD 260 backhoe trench bucket for \$346.67. All ayes. Motion carried.
8. Motion Marth, sec. Paulus to approve freight cost of \$248.81 that wasn't in original bid from Electric Pump for the sewer pump and basket. All ayes. Motion carried.
9. Motion Marth, sec. Arndt to donate \$500.00 to the Rockford Historical Society. All ayes. Motion carried.
10. RRMR Summer Rec property was tabled until next meeting.
11. Motion Marth, sec. Paulus to not waive late water and sewer penalty for RRMR utility bill. All ayes. Motion carried.
12. Motion Marth, sec. Johnson to approve City Clerk Pam Hopper and Deputy Clerk Jessica Dow to attend the Data Tech User Group meeting on April 24th, 2018, with City Hall to be closed that day. All ayes. Motion carried.
13. Motion Marth, sec. Johnson to approve the appointment of Danny Miller to the Rockford Municipal Light Plant Board with term to expire April 1, 2024. All ayes. Motion carried.
14. Motion Marth, sec. Arndt to approve Resolution #2018-07 Authorizing transfer of sewer savings funds in the amount of \$23,553.29 to the sewer checking funds. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

15. Motion Johnson, sec. Marth to approve adding Cyber theft protection to the city's insurance policy. All ayes. Motion carried.
16. Johnson Addition Lots was tabled until next meeting.
17. Public Works Director Randy Schweizer discussed snow removal and broken wing on snow plow.
18. Mayor Johnson discussed the May 1 Bond informational meeting for the Floyd County Sheriff's office and encourages anyone who can attend upcoming meetings to do so if possible.
