

## ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING JUNE 14<sup>TH</sup>, 2018

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at City Hall on Thursday June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Council Members Paulus, Stokes, Johnson, Arndt with Marth being absent. Citizens present were Dennis Ginther, Monica Murray, Andy Achenbach, and Employee Randy Schweizer.

Motion Stokes, sec. Arndt to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. Motion Arndt, sec. Johnson to approve the consent agenda consisting of April 17<sup>th</sup>, May 8<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims and Expenses, and Liquor License for Rockford Volunteer Fire Department. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
3. Motion Johnson, sec. Stokes to purchase a vibra plate compactor up to \$1,500.00. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
4. Motion Paulus, sec. Arndt to approve variance at 703 1<sup>st</sup> Ave SE for fence to be built up to property line. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
5. Motion Johnson, sec. Paulus to give permission to use Central Park and to block off streets to be used for Rockford Fun Days on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and also to have a copy of the license and liability paperwork into City Hall for fireworks. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
6. Motion Paulus, sec. Johnson to waive the building permit fee for the Rockford Historical Society. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
7. Motion Arndt, sec. Paulus to donate \$300.00 to Grow for the community development plan. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
8. Motion Johnson, sec. Stokes to approve Auchstetter's Floor Cleaning to clean and wax floors at City Hall for \$225.00. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
9. Motion Johnson, sec. Arndt to approve Resolution #2018-10 setting Salary and Wage policy for Non-Union employee. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
10. Motion Johnson, sec. Stokes to approve Mayor Scott Johnson and City Clerk Pam Hopper to sign the Local Disaster Declaration for the storm that came through on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.

11. Discussion was held on the sales of Johnson Addition properties and the proper procedures on how to do so and will be started at next month's council meeting.
12. Public Works Director Randy Schweizer discussed the storm clean up and appreciates all the help from all the volunteers who have helped out with clean up.

Mayor Scott Johnson discussed the storm clean up and presented to the council that Red Cross was here right away and were very happy with the organization of the emergency crews, City and Light Plant employees and all the volunteers. Scott also let the council know that he authorized Randy to purchase 2 Grapple buckets for the help of the cleanup from the storm.
