

**ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING**

**AUGUST 11, 2020  
7:30 P.M.**

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at the Rockford Community Center to help ensure adequate space for social distancing on Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Council Members Johnson, Arndt, Hoffarth, Hirv & Stokes. Citizens present were Alvin Marth, Cory Marth, Jana Crimmings, Josiah Stokes, Stacie Stokes and Employee Randy Schweizer.

Motion Stokes, sec. Johnson to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. No Public Hearing for Johnson Addition Lot's 3 & 4 due to no bids.
3. Motion Hirv, sec. Hoffarth to approve the agenda consisting of July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, and Claims & Expenses and Yesway Liquor License. All ayes. Motion carried.
4. Cory Marth thanked the council for their generous donation to his 2019 Eagle Scout Project and wanted to return the remaining balance from the project of \$31.45 that wasn't used.
5. Motion Hoffarth, sec. Arndt to approve \$1,000.00 donation to Josiah Stokes for his Corn Hole Game Eagle Scout project in Wyatt Park. Funds will be paid from the Laudner Fund. Passed all ayes with Stokes abstaining. Motion carried.
6. Motion Hoffarth, sec. Stokes to approve the purchase of 8 new Trash Receptacles for the parks from Plastic Recycling of Iowa Falls, Inc. Funds will be paid from the Laudner Fund All ayes. Motion carried.
7. Lift Station – Lid and Pump Financing tabled until next meeting.
8. Sewer/Water Rate Study tabled until next meeting.
9. Motion Johnson, sec. Arndt to approve Resolution #2020-14 Authorizing transfer of Emergency Funds in the amount of \$5,405.02 to General Fund account. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
10. Public Works Director Randy Schweizer reported on 4 emergency calls, tree removals, mowing, the water tower painting project, and wanting to get quotes for a stump grinder for the tractor.

11. Mayor Johnson spoke with the council on the Johnson addition lots, park projects and wanting to meet with the park committee on different ideas, and the possibility of a part-time grant writer for the city.
