Motion Stokes, sec. Arndt to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
2. Motion Arndt, sec. Stokes to open the Maximum Property Tax Levy Public Hearing at 7:31 P.M. for purposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Maximum Property Tax Levy as published. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Mayor Pro Tem Hirv asked for any written or oral objections or comments: there being none, Motion Stokes, sec.
