

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at the Rockford Community Center to help ensure adequate space for social distancing on Tuesday July 13, 2021. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were Council Members Hirv, Stokes, Johnson, Arndt, and Hoffarth. Citizens present were Kevin Tegtmeier and Employee Randy Schweizer.

Motion Hoffarth, sec. Arndt to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. Motion Stokes, sec. Hirv to approve the agenda consisting of June 8th, 2021 Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims & Expenses and Liquor License for Rockford Volunteer Fire Department. All ayes. Motion carried.
3. Discussion was held with Mayor Johnson on the meeting he had with Chris Diggins from NIACOG for funding for water tower and sewer lagoon projects.
4. Discussion was held on the letter from the Iowa DNR the city received about recordkeeping for the Wastewater Treatment Facility from the DNR inspection.
5. Motion Johnson, sec. Hirv to waive community center fee for the rental from the non-profit PEO committee on October 23rd, 2021. All ayes. Motion carried.
6. Motion Johnson, sec. Hoffarth to approve purchase of a new water fountain from Kay Park for \$1,584.06 to replace the one at Central Park. Ayes: Stokes, Johnson, Hoffarth and Hirv. Nays: Arndt. Motion carried.
7. Motion Johnson, sec. Hirv to approve transfer of \$2,500.00 from sewer checking to sewer reserve fund every month for sewer lagoon project. All ayes. Motion carried.
8. Motion Arndt, sec. Johnson to approve Resolution #2021-13 Transfer of LOST Fund to Water Fund. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
9. Mayor Johnson reported on possibly resurfacing the tennis court and adding a pickle ball court to West Park.
10. Employee Randy Schweizer reported on the work that was done to the gazebo at Central Park, the water fountain, trimming of trees and asked ideas on different ways he could control traffic at the George Wyatt Park Campground the night of July 24th for the JT Tumilson fireworks.
