ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING & REGULAR MEETING

SEPTEMBER 12, 2023, 7:30 P.M.

- 1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at the Rockford City Hall on Tuesday, September 12th, 2023. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. Present were Council Members Enabnit, Schlader, Seibert, and Hoffarth. Medlin was absent. Citizens present were Chelsea Carroll, Harry White with Sunset Generation, and Spenser Gruis at 7:31 and Employee's Randy Schweizer and Dan Paulus.
 - Motion Hoffarth, sec. Seibert to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
- 2. Motion Enabnit, sec. Schlader to open the Public Hearing at 7:30 P.M. for Authorizing Conveyance of interest in real estate of property of portion of 2nd Street S.E., Rockford, Iowa. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Mayor Johnson asked for any written or oral objections or comments: there being none, Motion Hoffarth, sec. Seibert to close Public Hearing at 7:31 P.M.
- 3. Motion Schlader, sec. Hoffarth to approve Resolution #2023-35 approving Conveyance of interest in real estate of property of portion of 2nd Street S.E. from Main Ave to Alley, Rockford, Iowa to First Link 11, LLC. Passed with the following roll call vote: Ayes: Seibert, Hoffarth, Enabnit, and Schlader.
- 4. Motion Hoffarth, sec. Enabnit to approve the consent agenda consisting of August 8th & 28th, 2023 Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims and Expenses. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
- 5. Motion Hoffarth, sec. Schlader to approve a \$186.37 sewer credit to 509 W. Main Ave for their August bill. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
- 6. Employee Daniel Paulus passed out a new Water Tower Project schedule to the council and mayor.
- 7. No action was taken on Sewer Lagoon Project.
- 8. Discussion was held on phase #2 of the West Park Sidewalk project that Sharon Enabnit and Carol Hoffarth. They are applying for another grant through the Floyd County Community Foundation.
- 9. Motion Seibert, sec. Enabnit to approve Halloween trick or treating in Rockford for Sunday, October 29th, 2023, and a donation of \$300.00 towards treat bags for the parade. The parade will begin at 5:00 P.M. in the old clinic parking lot. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
- 10. Harry White with Sunset Generation informed the council that the program has went over budget the last 6 months with food expenses. He said that Elderbridge's monthly contribution to Sunset Generation was cut from what they were getting extra for COVID. The council suggested that the Sunset Generation Committee have a meeting with their cook and Elerbridge to discuss funding and to see if the senior center is still utilizing the US Foods and Northeast Iowa Food Bank trucks for the ordering and purchase of most of their groceries.
- 11. Motion Schlader, sec. Enabnit to approve Resolution #2023-36 Street Finance Report. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
- 12. Public Works employee Randy Schweizer reported on work to the library air condition unit, illegal garbage burning warning, at large dog warning and citation, black dirt they got from Scott Ginther, asbestos removal at 109 W. Main Ave, meetings with First Link, LLC. with Dollar General and cleaning the city hall garage.
- 13. Mayor Johnson reported on meetings he has had with First Link, LLC with Dollar General, the Economic Development meeting, and looking into different possible options for garbage.
- 14. Motion Seibert, sec. Enabnit to adjourn at 8:28 P.M.

Sunset Generation-Sunset Generation of Rockford, a nonprofit, is seeking donations for the meal program. 
