

**ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING
& REGULAR MEETING**

**JUNE 13, 2023
7:30 P.M.**

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at the Rockford City Hall on Tuesday, June 13th, 2023. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. Present was Council Members Seibert, Hoffarth, Enabnit, and Schlader with Medlin absent. Also present were Citizens William Schmidt, Spenser & Heidi Gruis, Dusten Rolando with Heartland Asphalt and Employee Daniel Paulus.

Motion Enabnit, sec. Hoffarth to approve the agenda as posted. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. Motion Schlader, sec. Seibert to open the Public Hearing at 7:30 P.M. to open sealed bids for City Lot RFD E20' W44' Lot 7 Block 12. Passed all ayes roll call vote. Mayor Johnson asked for any written or oral objections or comments: there being none, Motion Hoffarth, sec. Enabnit to close Public Hearing at 7:31 P.M.
