

ROCKFORD CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING DECEMBER 10, 2024
7:30 P.M.

1. The Rockford City Council met in regular session at City Hall on Tuesday, December 10, 2024. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. Present were Council Members Seibert, Medlin, Johnson, Enabnit, and Schlader. Citizens present were Spenser Gruis and Scott Gruis. Employee's present was Daniel Paulus and Heidi Stufflebeam.

Motion Enabnit, sec. Johnson to approve the posted agenda. Passed all ayes roll call vote.

2. Motion Johnson, sec. Medlin to approve the consent agenda consisting of November 12th & December 3rd Council Minutes, Monthly Reports, Claims & Expenses. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
3. City Hall Security Alarm was tabled until next meeting.
4. Motion Schlader, sec. Medlin to set the City Wide Clean-up dates from June 4-8, 2025 with 30 yard dumpsters to be put at the city dump for in town Rockford residents only, with hiring Dennis Fenton to oversee the residents and all items being brought in on those dates. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
5. Motion Johnson, sec. Enabnit to approve Mayor Johnson's appointment of Zoey Graham as Library Board Trustee to fill out the remainder of Jean Buseman term of June 30th, 2028. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
6. Motion Johnson, sec. Seibert to approve Resolution #2024-26 transfer of Water Funds to Capital Water Tower Fund. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
7. Motion Schlader, sec. Enabnit to approve Resolution #2024-27 transfer of Water Funds to Capital Improvement Debt Service Fund. Passed all ayes roll call vote.
8. City Hall office lease agreement tabled.
9. Motion Seibert, sec. Johnson to approve carryover of Public Works Assistant Jeff Eilertson's week vacation into 2025. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.

10. Motion Enabnit, sec. Johnson to approve the presented Union Contract for 2 years contingent upon the Rockford Municipal Light Plant Board's approval. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
11. Motion Seibert, sec. Schlader to set Budget Workshop meeting for January 15th, 2025 at 5:30 P.M. Passed all ayes. Motion carried.
12. Public Works Employee Daniel Paulus reported on the cleaning & organizing of the public works building and office, surveys for the wastewater grant, ordering of the new welder and equipment all ready for winter.
13. Councilman Schlader reported to the council that he received a really nice compliment about the city workers job performance's and wanted to thank them for all their hard work.
14. Councilwoman Enabnit reported to the council that she has been approached again this year to see if the city could hang flags and Christmas lights on the west side of town.
15. Mayor Johnson told the council he is waiting to hear back with the city attorney on what she is drafting for the city hall office lease agreement, filling out paperwork for the grant for the demo of 109 W Main, and the Holiday Stroll being this coming weekend on Saturday, December 14th.
